2002–2006 Ramsay Merriam Grant for the Preservation of Indigenous Craft Traditions, Ramsay Merriam Fund, Washington, D.C.*

* I was awarded a grant from the Ramsay Merriam Fund for the purpose of introducing stoneware technology to Nepalese potters. My Nepalese colleagues and I set up the first stoneware facility in the country in the village of Thimi and formulated new high-fire clay and glazes using local materials. I also created a range of tableware designs for the Thimi potters to produce for the export market. Due to the success of the project, the Ramsay Merriam Fund decided to award an additional grant for continuing my work in Nepal. With the second grant, we established a training facility where more potters from the village can have the opportunity to learn about the new methods and techniques for ceramics production. We have also designed an online resource for people worldwide to learn about the ceramic making traditions and culture of Nepal.
